



Terms and Conditions for Parents Registering Their Children at Move Dance Sport Academy L.L.C. (“MDSA”)

1. Registration and Fees

- A completed registration form is required before your child can attend classes.
- Fees must be paid in advance, as stated on the registration website.

2. Attendance and Punctuality

- Parents/guardians must ensure timely drop-off, no earlier than 10 minutes before the start of the dance class, at the designated meeting point.
- Children aged 12 and above, or those with written parental consent, must arrive at least 5 minutes before the start of class to the venue of the training.
- Children must be collected at designated meeting point within 15 minutes after the end of training.
- If a parent/guardian is delayed, they must call the coach immediately.
- MDSA coaches can supervise children for up to 15 minutes after the session ends. After this period, a late collection fine of 50 AED may be applied.
- After three instances of repeated tardiness, MDSA reserves the right to deny the child participation in sessions.
- Children under 8 years must be accompanied to the meeting point by a parent/guardian.
- Written consent is required for children aged 8–12 to travel to and from sessions independently.
- Children aged 12 years and above may make their own way to and from the facility or activity zone.
- Parents/guardians must communicate any medical conditions, allergies, or additional needs on the registration form. Updates must be shared with the coaches before the next session.
- Parents/guardians must respect the rules of the facility while waiting or entering designated areas.
- If a child is unable to attend a session, notice must be sent in writing to admin@movedsa.com.
 - Without a medical certificate, the absence cannot be accepted and no refund will be given.
 - With a valid medical certificate, the missed sessions will be credited toward the next term's payment.



3. Clothing and Safety

- Children must wear appropriate dance clothing and shoes.

4. Health and Injuries

- Parents must inform MDSA of any medical conditions or allergies.
- The head coach always has a fully equipped first aid kit.
- Our coaches hold Level 3 First Aid and AED qualifications.
- In case of injury, first aid will be provided and parents will be contacted.

5. Behaviour and Respect

- Children are expected to behave respectfully towards coaches and classmates.
- Repeated disruptive behaviour may result in exclusion from classes.

6. Communication

- Parents must ensure contact details are up to date.
- Important notices will be shared by email or WhatsApp.

7. Liability

- MDSA will take every possible care to ensure your child's safety and well-being.
- However, the academy cannot be held responsible for accidents or incidents beyond its reasonable control.
